

Camp Ramah in New England Retreat and Rental Information



Facilities

Accommodations: Guests can choose the type of “camp” experience they are looking for through their housing package. We offer a range of housing options. There are hotel style accommodations with private rooms and bathrooms, a variety of semi private rooms that have shared bathrooms and to get the full feel of camp, bunks are available for families as well. Some of our rooms are heated and/or air conditioned.



The Herb and Barbara Greenberg guest house – 6 rooms each equipped with 2 queen sized beds, heating/air conditioning, and a private bathroom. Linens and towels are included. **Guest house accommodations require an additional fee.**



Tikvah/Voc. Ed House – Our *Tikvah* house, located in our special needs *Tikvah* village, is equipped with 5 heated/winterized rooms of various sizes that can house between 2-8 people per room. Each room has its own bathroom. This building also has a lounge and kitchenette space. Rooms do not come with linens.



Cabins – The true camp feeling can be experienced by bunk living. Guests have the opportunity to live in either one of our four *Tikvah* bunks (which do have heating) or one of the many non-winterized bunks. There’s plenty of space and each bunk has its own bathroom.

Meeting Spaces: Camp Ramah offers indoor and outdoor facilities for meeting and programming. We have intimate classroom settings and amenities for large group programming. Many of our buildings are newly renovated.



Our *beit midrash* complex is comprised of three buildings; a fully stocked library, classrooms, and a *beit kneset*. The complex has both heat and air conditioning and offers groups multiple meeting room options for running programs simultaneously.



The *beit am bet* is our newly renovated indoor recreational space that can hold 500 people. It is a heated/winterized facility that has a kosher kitchen and is equipped to feed upwards of 150 people.

The staff lounge building is also equipped with both heat and air conditioning. It offers more meeting room options and can accommodate 40 people comfortably in its open lounge style space. There is a small kosher kitchen here as well.

Recreation: Camp Ramah in New England offers full recreational facilities. We have soccer fields, basketball and tennis courts, baseball diamonds, and small indoor areas for group games, dancing and activities. Our beautiful lake in the middle of camp provides in-season swimming and boating opportunities.



Meals:



Dinning during the summer and for in-season rentals is under the supervision of a mashgiach in our *chadar ohel* - kosher kitchen and dining hall. Pre and post-season rentals, have the option of providing their own kosher food or taking advantage of our catered kosher options for an additional fee. A complete listing of meals and catering options is available upon request.
