

Incentive Grant Summary for Kayitz (Summer) 2016:

The Foundation for Jewish Camp is offering a limited number of incentive grants for first-time campers -- \$1000 off of tuition for any eligible first-time camper attending a 4-or-8-week program who does NOT attend a Jewish Day School. These grants are available in the following communities:

Hartford, CT Boston, MA (including the North Shore) Syracuse and central NY Rhode Island Washington, DC (VERY LIMITED numbers)

The PJ Library program is offering a limited number of \$1000 incentive grants for first-time campers who DO attend a Jewish Day School. These grants will be awarded by lottery. The Harold Grinspoon Foundation offers grants to residents of Western MA and Southern VT up to \$1500 for first-time campers and \$1000 for returning campers. Please note: Campers may not double-dip the above grants. A camper is only eligible for ONE of these grants.

For any first-time Ramah campers attending a 4-8 week program (who have never before participated in a 4-8 week program at a Jewish overnight camp) who are not eligible for any of the above incentive grants (because they do not live in a participating region, or because they attend a Jewish Day School), Camp Ramah in New England can offer a **\$500 discount on tuition, while supplies last.** This is supported by our own funders. After registering for camp, please e-mail our Finance Associate Ken Milgram at <u>KMilgram@campramahne.org</u> to be sure you are on the list for this discount. This discount is not offered to the children of Ramah staff-members.

Camp Ramah has additional first-time incentive grants available for new campers attending a 4-8 week program who **are members of certain partner Conservative Movement shuls in our region**. Please contact Josh Edelglass at <u>joshe@campramahne.org</u> for more information.
