Nivonim Personal Statement: Materials: 70 pieces of paper, maybe more. 70 writing utensils. 4 groups

Goal: To develop a personal mission statement or nivonim statement for each camper for the rest of the summer.

Step1: Introduce Peula by talking about how weve spoken a lot about how the eidah can be great, but a huge part of the eidah is how each individual comes together to be the best they can be and create an eidah that's greater than the sum of it's parts.

Step two: Have everyone write a paragraph about what they want out of themselves for the next two weeks to be as great a person and nivonimer they can be.

Step three: they should then try to condense there paragraph into one statement. When they all have a personal statement. Each camper if they choose should share the statement.

Step four : facilitator should discuss how. When we think if a place at camp we spend time thinking of just our closest friends, Discuss how while we may be closer to some people, what really makes camp is all the individual puzzle pieces in the eidah. Each of them is a puzzle piece that makes the eidah who it is. A puzzle can be great without one piece, but it can never be whole without each piece.

Step five: Have them use there statements as puzzle pieces. One by one, they should put theyre pieces together. In order to put down theyre puzzle piece, they must say how theyre personal statement, while it a personal goal, truly helps fill the eidah. Campers are encouraged to help eachother out. When the puzzle is finished it will be a demonstration about how individually they are able to create something special within the puzzle and in their eidah as a whole.
