Goal: Tefilat Haderech, New Beginnings

- *Notes for Group Leaders: for many of the stations, there will be more groups than station leaders, so you will need to help man the stations with the station leader and for your group.
- *Notes for all Madrich: if you are not scheduled for a station or as a group leader for a specific time, go help a fellow madrich in need

Morning Stations:

- Pet Rocks (Jake & Dana)
 - Location: *outside near the omanut tent*
 - Explanation: *have kids go out and get their own rock to paint*
 - Materials: *rocks, paint, paintbrushes, water bucket*
 - "May You send blessing in our every handiwork"
- Bandannas/Headbands (Ashley & Ya'ara)
 - Location: *picnik tables near swings on Upper Migrash*
 - Explanation: *give each kid a white head band to decorate*
 - Materials: *white headbands, paint, paint brushes, water bucket*
 - "and make us reach our desired destination for life, gladness, and peace."-the piece of Tfilat Haderech that I thought fit the best here. We want to be happy on the way?
- Sneaky Sahal (Edan)
 - Location: *front of camp lower migdrash*
 - Explanation: *have kids learn army crawls and camouflage etc.*
 - Materials: *face paint, leaves*
 - "that You lead us toward peace, emplace our footsteps towards peace, guide us toward peace,"

Afternoon Stations:

- Ice Tag (Edah)
 - Location: *lower migrash*
 - Explanation: *see rules below at 2:35 time slot*
 - Materials: *6 hula hoops, poster w/ quote of Tfilat Haderech, 85 small copies of quote to give to campers*

- Shrinky Dink (Violet & Zev)
 - Location: *tent outside omanut building*
 - Explanation: *make shrinky dinks of brachot to hang in the bunk for protection*
 - Materials: *shrinky dink paper, colored pencils*
 - “and grant us peace, kindness, and mercy in your eyes and in the eyes of all who see us.”
- Tribal Dance/ War Song (Sam & Adam)
 - Location: *moadan ilanot*
 - Explanation: *see explanation below in 3:15 time slot*
 - Materials: *Poster with T'filat Haderech quote, 3 hebrew word banks for chant, 85 copies of quotes from Tfilat Haderech to give to the campers when they complete the station*
- Battle/Capture the Counselor (Edah)
 - Location: *lower migrash*
 - Explanation: *see explanation below in 4:45 time slot*
 - Materials: *6 maps of camp ramah, copy of edah song, copy of daily schedule*
 - “Blessed are You, Eternal One, who hears prayer”

 - explain what the yom is (**Jake**)
 - meet in moadon to watch 20 min clip of beginning of narnia (projector, white screen)

Tuesday Afternoon

- 2:35
 - Ice tag
 - 1. Sharone introduces the quote from Tefilat Hadrech in Hebrew and English “May You rescue us from the hand of every foe, ambush, bandits and wild animals along the way and from all manner of punishments that assemble to come to Earth.”
 - 2. Liav introduces and explains the rules of “Ice Tag” as follows:
 - In Ramarniah, several enemies are loose. These enemies have the ability to freeze you.
 - Eight kids will be designated “it” (the enemies)
 - When you are tagged, you lie down and put your hands and feet in the air
 - Four people come and each one holds an arm or a leg
 - These four people carry you to a hospital. They are safe while they carry you. Stations will be designated by hoola hoops
 - At the hospital a counselor will listen to the four people say, “V’Tatzilenu MiCaf Kol Oyev BaDerech”
 - The frozen person is then free to get up and run around again
 - 3. After about half an hour, Sharone will call everyone back together and tell them that groups 1-3 are going to Omanut and groups 4-6 are going to the Moadon
 - Counselors: Yaara, Matan, Barry, Adam, Dana, and Liav will stand at the hula hoops and listen to the kids say the phrase. Everyone else will act as referees along the perimeter.

 - Shrinky Dinks
 - 3:40 - Groups 1,2,3
 - 4:25 - Groups 4,5,6
 - Tribal Dance/War Song

 - **Tribal Dance Explanation:**
 - 1. Ya'ara introduces the station with a quote from T'filat Haderech: "May You hear the sound of our supplication, because You are the God who hears prayer and supplications"
 - 2. Ya'ara explains that each group should come up with a special war song or chant and dance to prepare for the upcoming battle. The song must be in Hebrew. Adam will give an example of a Hebrew chant and some sample dance moves.
 - 3. Each group will be given a list of Hebrew words they may use when composing their songs.
 - 4. The groups will be given 20 minutes to prepare
 - 5. Each group will present their song and dance (20 minutes, target 5 minutes each)
 - Hebrew words: Shama, Tfilah, Netzachon, Milchama, Machaneh Ramah, Hashem,
- 5:15
 - Battle/Capture the Counselor
 - When campers find the counselors, the counselors need to give the campers a task to complete. The campers must complete the task completely before moving on. Counselors will give one representative from the group a token to show that they completed the task. First group to obtain all the tokens "wins".
 - Objective: final battle like in Narnia, defeating the "bad guys" (counselors). Making sure the kids know important things about camp in order to move on to the crowning ceremony.
 - Counselors and Tasks:
 - Matan - get campers to sing Edah song
 - Barry - get kids to recite daily schedule (regular)

- Sharone - have kids sing camp song
 - Tito - have kids recite camp words (agam, chadar, rikud, shira, moadoan, tzrif, chanichim, migrash, kfar)
 - Maya - sing rod-hayom
 - Jonathan - draw on camp of map with marker ways of how to get to moadoan ilanot from random places in camp

 - Crowning Ceremony: have Rabbi Gelb crown the Ilanoters at treehouse
