

# Ramah Family Camp Housing Details

It's probably been a while since you've lived in a bunk – or maybe you never have! Here are some things you need to know about living at camp, and specific details about any housing upgrades you may have chosen.

## Standard Bunk (no fee)-

This is the classic camp experience! You'll be staying in one of our regular camper bunks. The only difference is, you'll have it all to yourself! Each family, no matter how big or small, will have an entire bunk to themselves. You'll notice there's lots of room, and you probably won't use the whole thing. That's okay, enjoy it!

#### **Details**

- Private bathroom with toilets, showers, and sinks indoors. (We don't have any "shower houses" at Ramah).
- Electricity, including overhead lights and plenty of outlets
- Twin bunk beds. (Remember to bring your own sheets see packing list).
- No heating or air conditioning we recommend that you bring layers to wear at night; it could get chilly!

#### K'far Nivonim (\$50/room)

Built in 2012, this is our newest housing facility on campus. Each family will get a room to themselves (normally sleep 10 campers), as well as access to a large shared bathroom.

#### **Details**

- Shared bathroom with 1-2 other families. Each bathroom includes 4 toilets, 4 showers, and plenty of sinks. Bathrooms will be separated by gender.
- Twin bunk beds (Remember to bring your own sheets see packing list).
- Fully winterized facility, including heat and air ventilation.

#### Tikvah Bunks (\$100/bunk)

These are most similar to traditional camper bunks, except they have heat and air conditioning. ! Each family, no matter how big or small, will have an entire bunk to themselves. You'll notice there's lots of room, and you probably won't use the whole thing. That's okay, enjoy it!

#### **Details**

- Private bathroom with toilets, showers, and sinks indoors. (We don't have any "shower houses" at Ramah).
- Electricity, including overhead lights and plenty of outlets
- Twin beds. (Remember to bring your own sheets see packing list).

## Marp Upstairs (\$50/room)

Housed in our infirmary (Marp), these rooms typically accommodate up to eight campers at a time, but will be used for only one family. This building is full winterized, including heat and air conditioning.

#### Details

- Shared bathroom with 1-2 other families. Each bathroom includes Bathrooms will be separated by gender.
- Twin bunk beds (Remember to bring your own sheets see packing list).
- Fully winterized facility, including heat and air conditioning

## Marp Downstairs (\$120/suite)

Housed in our infirmary (marp), these rooms have double beds (with added single beds, when needed). Bathrooms are adjacent to each room.

#### **Details:**

- Full beds (Remember to bring your own sheets see packing list).
- Adjacent private bathrooms, or shared with one other family (depending on number of rooms reserved)
- Fully winterized facility, including heat and air conditioning.

## **Guest House (\$150/room)**

This hotel-quality accommodation is our highest level upgrade. Enjoy private rooms and bathrooms, as well as picturesque views of our lake. And you don't even have to bring your own sheets!

#### Details:

- Two full-beds per room
- Private bathroom
- Fully winterized facility, including heat and air conditioning
