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Goals:

- A. To Tie Together The theme of The summer.
- B. To demonstrate different people and ways who have/to change The world.
- C. To allow for each counselor in The צבא to develop (under guidance) Their own discussion group.

Outline:

A. Preparation

1. Create a list of The people/topics (They should correspond to that you would like to use.
2. Using The internet or other resource, track down ~~relevant~~ relevant primary information about The person and Their connection to The topic. Keep each packet relatively short (less than 15 pages).
3. Present The program to The צבא and ask each counselor to list Their top 6 choices.
4. Level The choices, keeping in mind counselor strengths, abilities to cope w/ disappointment, etc. Be SMART!
5. Present, on an individual basis, each counselor's materials and topic. Ask them to build a discussion group, do more research if they'd like to, and offer yourself or other resources if They need help. Tell Them you want to see Their discussion group by The Thursday before The program.
6. Review each discussion group and ~~and~~ give positive and constructive criticism.

Introduce (again) The topic and Then divide The group up.
It is most important to watch what messages are sent to The campers here. We suggest avoiding telling who The

people are, that each counselor planned their own discussion, or that not everyone is doing the same thing. It is MOST IMPORTANT here to pay careful attention to who is in what discussion group.
