

Goal: To teach the kids how to be a good leader by learning about the 5 jeopardy categories (help, listen, responsibility, lead, and to be a good role model)

Ariel: introduction.

After Ariel speaks, Tiki explains the rules.

Tiki:

- You are going to work with your bunk as a team to try and get as many points as possible.
- Each bunk will get a turn to pick a category and certain amount of points. They will then attempt to answer the question. If they get the question right, they win that amount of points. If they get the question wrong then all of the other groups have an opportunity to raise their hand and try to answer the question, and then receive the points.
- Every group must remain quiet when it is not your turn or else you will lose points.
- Each group needs to pick one person to be the speaker; only the speaker can answer the question AFTER consulting with the rest of their group.
- If your group gets a daily double, you must first answer the question. Only if you answer the question correctly, will you be given the task to do. If you answer the question correctly, and complete the task, then you will receive double the amount of points. If you answer the question incorrectly, the daily double then moves to the team who can answer the question correctly.

DAILY DOUBLES:

When a group lands on the 400 pt category TIKI will explain these rules:

Follower category- stepping stones with construction paper.

Tiki- We will give you construction paper. You must get from one side of the moadon to the other only using the pieces of construction paper we give you. No one can touch the floor while going across.

Helper category-

Tiki- you must play the human knot game. However, only one person can talk at a time and only helpful comments are allowed. If more than one person talks at a time, we will deduct points. If any mean or unhelpful comments are made, you fail the challenge. An example of a helpful comment is "You should put your foot in this space." An unhelpful comment is "You're doing that wrong."

Responsibility category-

Tiki- you must act out a scenario of when a leader would take on responsibility, and how to take the responsibility or give out responsibility the right way. If you do not cooperate or instead,

Listening category-

Tiki- Ariel will play simon says with you. You must follow everything she says or else you will fail the challenge.

Role Model category-

Tiki- you have to explain why you dressed up the way you did and how that represents being a good role model. If you are not prepared, you fail the challenge.

Final Jeopardy:

Ariel: The question for final Jeopardy is "When was camp founded?" Each bunk needs to decide how many points they want to bet. If you get the answer right, you get that amount of points, if you get the answer wrong, the amount of point you bet gets deducted from your score.
