Peulat Shabbat 8/15/2015

This will be about 20 minutes and then Yehudah will come.

Group Size: Small groups

Overall Theme: Community

Supplies/Resources: String, 50 cups, purple paper, 42 bowls, poster board

Ideal Location: Lower Migrash and Basketball Courts

Tzevet Preparation/ Roles: Group leaders, someone in charge of the seers, someone in charge of the runners, someone in charge of the builders. Each staff member is responsible for making sure that their group has correct building supplies (6 cups, purple paper, string).

Activity: Campers will be divided up in to three sub-groups within their groups – The seers, the runners, and the builders. In a hidden location, there is a picture that incorporates three of the aspects that the torah says creates a community. The Seers will be the only ones who are allowed to see the picture. They will describe it to the runners, who will then run to another location and tell the builders what to build with the given materials. The runners will go back and forth with questions for the seers until they think that the image the builders created is correct.

Aspects of a Community: Kashrut, Temple, Passover (Holidays)

Shua and Johanna – In charge of seers

Steph and Ellie – In charge of runners

RUNNING THE ACTIVITY

1. (Full Edah)
