

# Peulat Erev Tuesday July 15, 2014

**Goals:** Testing bunk unity+ Improoving bunk bonding

**Location:** Beit Am Gadol (NEED TO RESERVE)

**Structure:** Six Missions to Success

- Each Station will be 6 minutes
- 2 minutes for transitions and directions
- MADRICHIM: TIME YOUR STATIONS

1. Madrich: **Nicole**

The chanichim will have to put together three different puzzles which when complete compose a riddle. After figuring out the riddle they must answer it. The Madrich at the station will be timing them to see how long it takes. The Madrich will also be timing the station so the groups will know when to switch.

- a. If they bunk completes the puzzles and correctly answers the riddle and there is left over time in the rotation. They will complete a human pyramid.
- b. Puzzle Riddle: Who is the oldest Madrich? Acceptable answers:  
**Elad/Maya**

2. Madrich: **Stella**

How well do you know your bunk-mate? One bunk (2 kids) will step forward and be asked a question and they have to answer it about their bunk mate. If a chanich does not have a bunk mate they will elect to join a group they feel they know.

- a. The Chanichim will be given pencil and paper to write their answers on.

i. Questions

1. How many siblings does your bunk mate have?
2. What does your bunk mate hate to eat?
3. Does your bunk mate have a pet? (if yes how many)
4. What is your bunk mate's fathers name?
5. What chugim does your bunk mate have?
6. Which state is your bunk mate from?
7. What city is your bunk mate from?
8. What is your bunk mate's favorite color?
9. How does your bunk mate sleep? (Stomach or back)
10. How does your bunk mat prefer their toilet paper?  
(pulling down or pulling up)
11. What is your bunk mate's favorite swim stroke?

12. What is your bunk mate's level in the lake?
13. What brand is your bunk mate's shampoo?
14. What is your bunk mate's favorite baseball team?
15. What is your bunk mate's favorite candy?

3. Madrich: **Matt**

Flip a sheet without touching the floor. All the chanichim will stand on a sheet spread out on the floor and they will flip it over without anyone touching the floor. If they touch the floor they start over. The Madrich at the station will be timing how long the task takes them in addition to timing the station so the groups will know when to switch.

4. Madrich: **Ben**

Cup stacking competition. Split the bunk into two teams. The teams will get into lines. To complete the challenge the chanichim (one at a time) must stack the cups into a pyramid and then stack them down before the next chanich can go. See which team can get the most stacks in the allotted time.

5. Madrich: **Adin**

Three-legged race for answer. Chanichim will pair off and complete a three-legged race. Once the race is completed the chanichim will get a riddle which they need to answer.

- a. Who was acting Rosh when Judy was gone? **Noah**
- b. How many siblings do your madrichim have?
  - i. Bunk 1: **Leah:2 Stella:1 Yaara:**
  - ii. Bunk 3: **Shoham:1 Metal: Nicole:**
  - iii. Bunk 5: **Rebecca: 1 Naomi: 3 Yifat: Maya:**
  - iv. Bunk 17: **Kyle:1 Ben:**
  - v. Bunk 19: **Elad: 2 Matthew: Adin: 6**
  - vi. Bunk 33: **Noah: Gefen: 2**
- c. How do you say the word *house* in Hebrew? **Ba'it**
- d. Say the word *eat* in Hebrew in all three tenses. (Past, present, future)
- e. How do you say the word *shower* in Hebrew? **Miklachat**
- f. Why do you dip the parsley twice in salt water at the Passover seder?  
**As a symbolic representation of the peoples tears**
- g. What are the names of the teams from yom sport in Hebrew? **Cachol, lavan, yarok, adom**
- h. What does *yesh le kama hodaot* mena in English? HINT: Judy says it every morning after tefilot. **I have a few/some announcements**
- i. How do you say the word *chair* in Hebrew? **Kiseh**
- j. How do you say the word *window* in Hebrew? **Chalon**

6. Madrich: **Noah**

Pass the tennis ball/ orange with your elbows without letting it drop.
