Catching the chicken → (1 big game)

- everyone silent (in circle)
- how people interpret other peoples nonverbal actions differently - respond to it rather than clarifying
- 1 person acting like catching a chicken (not talking)
- 3 other people try to act like what they think 1st person is doing - all people will stay in circle
- At end the 4 people say what they were doing - most likely all will be different
- trying to imitate what person is doing - not the literal action
- Idea - without verbal communication people will interpret somebodies actions differently than what that person is actually trying to say (the donkey nonverbally trying to communicate to Balam) → Balam gets angry and uses violence against the donkey
