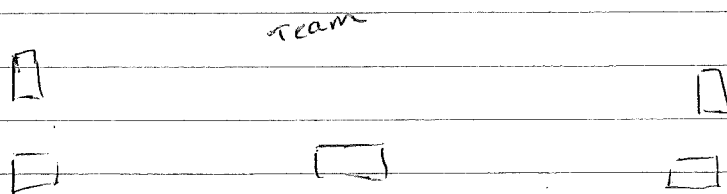
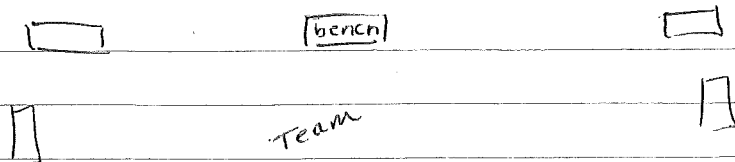
Rain plan: Beit Am Bet?

Rami will announce an imminent attack. Armies/teams: Top bunks vs. bottom bunks

Team 1: Nitzan, Tali, Sarah, Mira, Goldfarb, Or, Sahar, Solomon, Chennie

Team 2: Shana, Eli, Becca, Arielle, Rachel, Moser, Yaniv, Ashley, Ron

Staff should help clarify rules (see back)

- stand around borders and keep kids who are out in check

- cheer on teams

Rami will count down to start of game

Each team assigns 3 kids to be cities. They should not (cannot) move at all. Teams must protect cities

Each team lobbs "missiles" (balls) to try and hit cities and people.

can't just throw missiles; they must reach a certain height

can't catch balls (catch = explosion)

kid is out if touched by a missile

only way to protect self/cities: deflection using another ball
Missile is alive until it touches the ground

Goals: Friendly competition, teamwork, planning/strategy
