## Shoafim Peulat Shabbat 7/1

## Approximate Duration of Program: 35 minutes

**One-Line Description:** Perform skits about the parasha in small groups. Each group will have a small twist and after their performance the rest of the edah will guess what their twist was. **Overall Goal/Themes:** learn about the parasha in a fun way, show-up, leadership

### Instructions

- 5 minutes -- Split up into groups
- 3 minutes -- Go over the parsha summary
- 7 minutes -- Small group discussions
- 1 minute -- Introduce the twist to your group
- 10 minutes -- Create skit about parasha with the twist
- 10 minutes -- Present skits and guess each group's twist

## Summary:

- Moses learns about the red heifer, which is an animal whose ashes are used to purify Israelites who touch a dead body
- B'nai Yisrael arrives in Zin after wandering through the desert for 40 years
- Miriam dies, and everyone is thirsty
- Moses is instructed by G-d to speak to a rock and command it to give water
- Moses strikes the stone though, because he got angry at the Israelites who were rebelling
- G-d tells Moses that he and Aaron will not be allowed to enter the Promised Land
- Aaron dies and Elazar, his son, is succeeded in the high priesthood
- Venomous snakes attack B'nai Yisrael
- G-d tells Moses to place a brass serpent on a high pole
- Everyone who looks up at it will be healed

## **Discussion Questions:**

- Why did Moses hit the rock and not speak to it? How does it reflect on Moses's leadership? What does it mean to be a leader? How is it appropriate for leaders to act when they are under pressure? Is Moses's punishment fit for his actions?
