Goals:

- Hanichim will learn names of at least four other hanichim not in their tzrif.
- Hanichim will learn 2 new Hebrew phrases.
- Hanichim will learn about their tzevet and other members of their edah.
- Hanichim will become familiar with the Shoafim schedule.

Time: 1 hour

Summary:

Campers will be divided into predetermined groups, mixed up throughout the edah. Each kevutzah will be given a blank poster board with the objective of designing one letter/character of "Shoafim 2010." However, in order to obtain the necessary art supplies, the kevutzot must complete several tasks, outlined below. Only once all materials have been obtained may the kevutzot begin to design their piece of poster board.

Procedure:

1. Introduction (Sarah, Steven, Shana)
 - introduce staff with Chicago Bulls theme playing on speakers
 - rules (outlined and written down for all to see)
2. Rami and Hani skit (Solomon and Naomi)
3. Split hanichim into preset groups, each with one madrich (Mira, Tali)
4. Kevutzot complete the following tasks to receive each of their art supplies. They may not begin decorating their board until they receive all art supplies.
 - c. Name Game
 - d. Daber questions
 - e. Human Bingo Card
 - f. Staff Trivia
 - g. Yom-Yom charades
5. Upon completing all tasks successfully, kevutzot may decorate their letter/number. In the end, all 10 posters will be put together to create a sign saying "Shoafim 2010."

- copies of Daber dialogue (if needed)
- list of preset groups of hanichim
- 10 pieces of poster board
- iPod with Chicago Bulls theme
- iPod speakers

Instructions

Name Game:

- Whisper to them what perek we're in on the yom-yom
- Announce to the group what time it is on the yom-yom before each charade begins
- Help if they can't figure it out
- If they can't get it, they may say ONE word, only in Hebrew, as a clue (but not the name of the perek itself).
