

Jews Walk it Out: Character improvisation

- Each camper is told to bring 5 random, preferably Jewish affiliated items to the moadon.
- They are each grouped into about 8-10 groups.
- Each group is competing against one another
- The object of the game is to win as many points from the judges as possible. They have to dress up a representative from the group as a character said by the counselors. The counselors will judge them and give them points depending on how well they portray the characters announced. The kids have time to explain themselves after they finish walking down the runway.
 - The counselors make up a list beforehand of Jewish affiliated characters
 - i.e.- Lebron James at a Purim Party, Moses at a Bar mitzvah, Jacob and the coat of many colors, Cinderella's first trip to Israel.....
- There is a runway set up for the representatives from the groups to walk down as music is playing
- After each round (each character listed is a round), there are questions asked about the characters.
 - i.e.- Give us 5 facts about Israel, Tell me the story of Purim....
 - The first group to raise their hand gets a shot at answering these questions and winning more points.

Goals:

- Enjoyment with edah
- tests creativity
- allows campers to utilize their knowledge of facts about Judaism and Israel and share them with the rest of the edah
- a fun learning experience
- allows all campers to contribute their talents: wisdom, fashion, humor....
