Outstanding Peulat:

- Photo Scavenger Hunt- This allowed the campers to run around camp in their groups and meet people that they wouldn't normally talk to. The campers didn't just have to find things around camp but had to find people who knew certain things or had to reenact certain parts of the Bible or different verses from the Siddur.
- All girls program on Self Image- This program was a wonderful evening of showing the Shoafot that they are beautiful inside and out and that caring about what others think isn't as important as being proud of who you are. The program began with a clips from the movie Mean Girls, and then each girl got a hand-held mirror and had to draw write on a piece of paper what they love the most about the girl that they saw. Finally, they took a picture of a famous, beautiful celebrity and, around the circle, each person said something negative about that person and made a crease in the paper. After each person had gone, they went back around the circle and each person, as they said something nice about the woman in the picture, unfolded one of the creases. The message is that even if we say nice things, after we say mean things the damage is still done. You still see the lines in the paper even if you try to make up for the negative behaviors. We finished with another clip from mean girls and a reading of the poem Phenomenal Woman by Maya Angelou.
- Shipwrecked- This was a last minute game planned by my staff as a means of having our kids run around and exert lots of energy so they would go to bed. However, it ended up being a great Peulat Erev. The counselors began by giving lots of instructions. There were different commands that the counselors would shout and the campers would have to follow the directions. There were different calls for them to move forwards, backwards, left, or right, and also to do things in different groups, crawl on the ground, do silly things, etc. It was a great peulat erev and the kids had a blast.
