I, T'Kilat Haderech / Oh The Places You'll Go:

II,

-Teaching Mincha:

For this peulat Shabbat we had different stations for learning about mincha. One station was talking about nusach, what it means, and why it's important. We also taught the basic tune by using "It's the one and only cereal that comes in the shape of animals. It tastes so good and yummy, I want it in my tummy." We practiced using the tune to a couple different prayers in mincha. A second station was teaching a tune to "baruch elokeinu." The final station was teaching a tune to "Atah Echad." All of these were useful because at mincha, immediately after Peulat Shabbat, all tunes were used and the kids were able to participate.

III,

-Jewish Journey: We split them up into groups and talk about big Jewish events in their lives such as brit mila, bar mitzvah, and camp and how those things affect their Jewish identity. Then we facilitate a discussion about their future i.e. in college, marrying a Jewish spouse and raising kids. We took a map of camp and wrote in parts of this Jewish journey for them to follow.
