

Human Pacman Peulat Tzrif

Supplies

- benches - set up to create a maze
- 5 scooters - for packman and the ghosts to sit and scoot around on
- paper - torn up and placed around the maze (this is what pacman is trying to collect)
- hersheys kisses - there is one kiss in the maze and when pacman picks it up the ghosts have to freeze for ten seconds

It is played much like the video game version, pacman rolls around the maze trying to collect all of the papers before the ghosts tag her. pacman can switch directions but the ghosts cant, we also found that it was best to let pacman use hands and feet to maneuver but the ghosts only used their hands. Also pacman music is optional but recommended.

Beaded Curtain Peulat Tzrif

This peulat Tzrif is both an ice breaker and allows the kids to decorate the tzrif themselves.

Supplies: String, Beads, happy campers.

The kids each work on beading a string (premeasured) that will become part of a beaded curtain in a doorway of the tzrif. As they are beading the madrichot will randomly ask a chanicha what color bead is in her hand. The colors of beads correspond to preset ice breaker questions.

Peulat Banot- Paint twister

Supplies: King size sheets, lots of paint

The basic set up is to have different colors of paint blobbed down on the sheets randomly (it does not have to resemble a twister board). Then ask the banot to stand next to people who are not from their tzrif. To play a madricha will shout out the twisterlike commands. But instead of simply right hand red, it is "right hand red if you have lived in two or more states" that way the chanichot learn something about their edah mates, while theyre all having fun getting covered in paint and generally having fun.

This activity is not incredibly long because it devolves into a paint fight fairly easily but that's fun too!
