- 3. Evil Sorcerer stops him from leaving until he finds the magic key
- 4. Uses magical steed to go searching
- 5. Finds and helps rabbi for one piece
- 6. Finds and helps Chef for second piece
- 7. Finds and helps woman for third piece
- 8. Challenges the Sorcerer to a sports game with the help of sports player
- 9. Rafi returns to be Rosh Edah

Schedule:

- 1. Max and Marcus introduction
- 2. Head back to bunk for supplies for 5 MINUTES
- 3. Make four circles by bunk on Tzad Alef tennis courts
- 4. Story commences by Max and Marcus with entrée of drama
- 5. Character 1 is announced; 3 MINUTES to dress
- 6. Characters are presented; Max, Marcus, and Rafi judge
- 7. Character is chosen
- 8. Story continues
- 9. Rinse, repeat
