Parshat Pinchas:

Theme of Shabbat: Becoming a Leader

Program Overview: Campers will rotate in groups participating in different stations related to the different qualities of a leader.

There will be 8 groups of 10 campers each with one counselor running counselor running each station.

Station 1: Communication- Campers will sit in a circle and play a few games of telephone.

- Afterwards the counselor running the station will lead a discussion about the activity the campers did
 - o Questions:
 - Which quality of a leader do you think this station represents?
 - Why is this quality important to have?
 - What are different types of communication leaders could use?
 - Give an example of when you could be a leader on Tzad Aleph using communication skills.

Station 2: Leading by example- Campers will partner up with another person and one of them will make hand motions that the other one has to mimic. The first time they do this the “leader” will talk and will be able to say what the next motion is and the 2nd time they won’t speak.

- Afterwards the counselor will run a discussion about this activity
 - o Questions:
 - What quality of a leader did this activity represent?
 - Why is this an important quality?
 - What do you think leading by example means and how would you go about doing this in your every day life?
 - Which do you think is more effective; leading by example or leading by instruction?

Station 3: Listening- Counselor running will lead “Shimon Amor (symon says)”

- Afterwards the counselor running the station will lead a discussion about the activity the campers did
 - o Questions:
 - What quality did this activity represent?
 - Why is this quality important?
 - What makes a good listener?
 - What could interfere with being a good listener?

Station 4: Thinking on your feet- Campers will sit in a circle and their goal is to create a story out loud with each person contributing 1 word at a time. Set rules about what words they can say:

- Word has to be appropriate

- Not made up
 - Counselor will then lead a discussion
 - o Questions:
 - What quality did this activity represent?
 - Why is this important?
 - When would you have to think on your feet as a leader on Tzad Aleph?
 - When is important to take your time and think through a situation carefully rather than thinking on your feet?
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
