

### **Program Summary:**

A humorous skit about a group of very different Jews who spend Shabbat together teaches chanichim about Jewish pluralism and observance of Shabbat.

### **Overall Goal/Themes:**

- To encourage chanichim to think about how they celebrate Shabbat at camp and at home
- To introduce chanichim to a wide range of "types" of Jews

### **Methods Used:**

Skit, small group discussion

### **Supplies/Resources Needed:**

- Copies of the script for each actor
- Costumes/props for the skit

### **Ideal Location and Room Setup:**

A large room (or outdoor area) with space for a performance and for the edah to split into small discussion groups (Beit Am Bet)

### **Staff Preparation and Roles:**

- 6 staff members should be chosen in advance to be actors in the skit
- One madrich/a leads each small discussion group

### **Instructions for Running the Program:**

1. Perform the skit (Attachment 1) for the entire edah.
2. Split into small groups for a discussion

### **Questions for Group Discussion:**

- Which of the characters best represented you? Why?
- Did any of the characters offend you? Why?
- Did any of the characters inspire you? How?
- Is there anything you'd like to bring home with you from camp in terms of celebrating Shabbat?
- Is there anything you'd like to bring to camp that you do at home that you think would enhance Shabbat here?
- What are some ways you could learn to understand about the different movements of Judaism?
