

## Prayer Passport Peulah

Goal: To introduce the new campers to our tefillot and to leading tefillot

Each kid gets a folded piece of paper with the cover of the Israeli passport and their name on the front. We discuss the leadership sticker/lollipop system. At each station each kid gets another sheet of paper to add to their passport.

Station	Discussion
Zmirot	<p>Modeh Ani: teach mo's and modeh ani section, split into two groups and switch off who sings which part</p> <p>Halleluyah: go over meaning of words besides halleluyah and matching hand motions</p> <p>Or Chadash: go over words and hand motions (we take out our suns because we're welcoming the new light!)</p>
Sh'ma	<p>Barchu: This is the</p> <p>Sh'ma: We take out our shins and cover our eyes, go over the specific words of the sh'ma, then hand motions for v'ahavta</p>
Amidah	<p>Amidah: Teach the amidah choreography: bowing, three steps back and three steps forward, bow bow forward bow, tiptoes. Concentrate on what we say when we're leading (especially for the kedusha)</p>

After three rotations we sit back down and everyone gets a string to tie the pages together. We collect the passports.

Sing adon olam and head to aruchat boker.
