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Program Type: Peulat Shabbat

Approximate Duration of Program: 45 mins

Group Size: Edah

One Line Description:

Playing a festivals game with Jewish elements from the parashah and then playing the spectrum game with the mountains of blessings and curses

Overall Goal/Themes:

Learn about the parashah and about some key elements of Jewish life. Have competitive fun!

Methods Used:

Part 1: holidays game

Edah is split into five groups, each is assigned a holiday: Rosh Hashanah, Sukot+Simchat Torah, Chanukah, Purim, Passover. The game is retrieving things that belong to the holiday from the middle of the migrash and bring them back to your group. A representative from every group sets out for the search each turn. There are two special rules: tzdaka- every group must donate four of their turns and find something for each of the other four groups.

Kashrut- half the papers will be colored white and half will be red, the group must find a creative way to keep the two from touching when they set them up, like milk and meat.

Part 2: mountain spectrum game

One side of the spectrum is mt. Grizim and the other is mt. Eival. If a camper has a positive attitude towards something he'll go closer to mt. Grizim and so on.
