Theme- trusting each other, having faith, etc.

Rafi tells story about trust or faith.

Saturday morning- Rabbi Gelb comes and talks about trust at camp and camp as a makom kadosh.

Peulat shabbat- trust games

-4 groups:

partners--one person leads around the other through an obstacle course

-play charades with different volunteers

-discussion about trust

STEP ONE: meet on the migrash

STEP TWO: divide into 4 groups of 17-18

STEP THREE: each of us (matan, josh, shula, liza) splits them into partners. One puts on a blindfold and the other leads her to the amphitheater without touching. At a certain place we have them switch roles

STEP FOUR:

Discussion about trust: Group leader explains why we just did blindfolded activity- because there is trust issue between god and Moshe in parshat chukat- Moses hits the rock when he was supposed to talk to it to get water for the people. God then says that Moses can no longer enter the land of Israel.

Would you still trust Moses? Why or why not?
