Goals

- Tzrif unity
- Learn basic Hebrew terms for camp items

Instructions

After dinner, we will ask the campers to go back to their tzrifim and:

- Fill a bag with as many random items as they can find.
- Dress one person up with as many clothes as possible.

Tasks

- One person must dress up in kachol and lavan and entire tzrif sings an Hebrew song.
- Everyone in the tzrif must wear a kova meshuga and dance the hoedown.
- Create a flag for your tzrif. Explain its significance.
- Spell Shoafim (in Hebrew) with random items. Sing the edah song.
- Dress up like Arielle (Rosh Edah) and pretend to be her.

Items

- Toothbrush
- Funky sunglasses
- Umbrella
- Anything neon
- Bright flashlight
- Sunscreen
- Anything with polka dots
- Food
- Put on a bikini over your clothes

Overview

- We will be sitting by tzrif.
- Tasks and items will be interspersed and announced mostly in Hebrew.
- Each item and task will have a positive or negative point value.
- The first tzrif to complete the task or bring the item will receive the most/least points.

Madrichim roles

- Encourage your tzrif to bring random items, but don't let them see this list of items/tasks.
- Don't translate the Hebrew words we use. Instead, demonstrate the word. Have the chanichim repeat the Hebrew words.
