

**Magshimim Peulat Shabbat- Ten Commandments vs. Camp Ten Commandments**

Goal: Having the campers think about how they would want to rate the Ten Commandments in order of importance.

Do we actually follow these rules in our daily lives?

Should we follow these rules? Why/why not?

Also, get the campers thinking about what should be the camp's Ten Commandments.

What would make camp a better place?

What makes us good campers?

Are these similar to the actual Ten Commandments?

Activity: Divide the *edah* into 6 groups.

Game of charades begins:

Have campers act out and guess either an actual commandment or a camp commandment.

Read out each commandment and have each camper place themselves on the spectrum of importance (1-10).

For those from 7-10 (really important): Why do you find this commandment important?

Try to convince other campers to join your place on the spectrum.

For those from 1-3 (really unimportant): Why don't you find this commandment important?

For those from 4-6 (in the middle): Why are you neutral?
