6. Read out loud the following words, and tell them to stand by the category that they feel most closely relates to the prompt or gets the most experience out of the given prompt; make them explain why they chose to stand where they did (not all, but a couple per statement)
  - o Chug
  - o Tfilot
  - o Etgar
  - o Color War
  - o Edah Programing
  - o Banim Banot Bonding
  - o The Lion King
  - o The Play
  - o Kabbalat Shabbat
  - o Seudat Shlishit
  - o Berkshires
  - o Tzrif Activities
