Peulat Shabbat Ve'etchanan

Goal: Teach chanichim about the Ten Commandments and explain their connection to Jewish values.

Materials:

- Ball
- Slips of paper with 10 commandments.

Steps:

- 1. 0-15 Edah ice breaker: pass around a ball and each kid says their name and their favorite emoil.
- 2. 15-20 Introduce the peulah and split into 5 groups of 10.
- 3. 20-40 Charades: each group splits down the middle into two groups of 5. Each group has 2 kids at a time stand up and a madrich will show them a slip of paper with a commandment. They have to simultaneously act it out and whichever side gets it first gets a point. Then call up the next kid from each side and pick a new commandment. Continue until all commandments have been acted out.
- 4. 40-50 Discussion: (place slips with ten commandments in the middle of the circle so kids can see)
 - a. If you could add one commandment, what would it be? Why?
 - b. If you had to take away one commandment, what would it be? Why?
 - c. What values that you have made you choose the commandments you chose?
 - d. How do these values affect how you act at camp?

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
