

**Peulat shabbat- Where are we going as an Eidah this summer**

**Goals:**

campers will understand the importance of caring for each other inside a group.  
Campers will see how its possible to help out a group without „harming themselves”

**Instructions:**

1. By groups we will spread out around the Beit-Knesset.
2. Give the group background about the peula- new session, how do we want our Eidah to look like this summer?

1. Game 1- Matbeout Zahav
2. on the floor will be pieces of paper with numbers 1 through 31 printed on them.
3. The point of the game is to step on all 31 numbers in order.
4. For each step you get a point. (you can't step on two numbers in a row.)
5. The winner is the camper who adds up to the most points.
6. There are 7 golden coins in the 'bank'.
7. If a player steps on more than 2 numbers, he will still get a point but the bank loses one golden coin.
8. If the bank loses all 7 golden coins, the team loses and starts over.
9. After the group has accomplished the task, sit them down and read source #1.
10. after reading the source text, ask the leading questions, and summery of the first part.
11. The prize for the task is a part of game 2- being selfish or caring for the other.
12. In the same group, put 8 cookies on the floor. Tell the campers that that's their prize and they can feel free to take as many as they wants. Not having a cookie per camper leads us to our next discussion:
13. Should I care just for myself and only make sure I get a cookie? Or make sure that the rest of my friends in the group should each get a cookie? And of course, needing to act as fast as possible in order to get a cookie.
14. Read out source 2.
