There are two teams for Yom Mayim. The madrichim are the team captains. They are responsible for assigning hanichim to each event, informing them of their role in the event, and getting the hanichim to each event. Madrichim are also responsible for RUACH; cheers, songs... ALL CHEERS MUST BE IN HEBREW! POINTS WILL BE TAKEN OFF FOR NON-HEBREW CHEERS.

The madrichim will receive a list of the events and hanichim on their team. The events will consist of a round robin for the first two hours. Each event has enough slots for all hanichim to participate. The round robin events will be competitions WITHIN THE EDAH, i.e. Halutzim-JAFFA will compete against Halutzim-ZION.

The Apache Relay will be a inter-edah relay. All Tzad Aleph hanichim will participate in the Tzad Aleph Apache. For example a Halutzim-Jaffa swimmer may be tagging a Shoafim-Jaffa swimmer. THEREFORE, when the madrichim get the list of Apache events, the madrichim from Halutzim through Shoafim and Magshimim through Nivonim must assign their Apache participants together.
