d) *Machon Trip*

The theme for the Machon trip was *Ramah Ba'Rechov*, and extension of *Reiyah Rechavah*. Many of our campers' friends who did not spend the summer before sophomore year at camp may have been traveling the country or Israel with USY or other youth groups, whose focus is to look at how Judaism operates outside of the ideal environment of a place like camp. As our campers learn to see the world in a broader sense and as they prepare for the college hunt, we sought to provide a taste of the "Judaism on the road" goals of USY on Wheels and comparable experiences, hence the theme *Ramah ba'Rechov*.
