**Fun Facts:**

- Lives in a house under the migrash (alive)
- Founded Ramah
- Wrestled a bear
- Helped Ben Yehuda create the Hebrew language
- Invented the word antidisestablishmentarianism
- Choreographed Ziben Ziben in 1975 while riding a hot air balloon across the Mediterranean
- Once jumped aboard a moving train and rode it all the way around space
- Was briefly married to a Rondeau- during that time, she tried all of Rondeau's then 46 flavors and felt like something was missing and created Alvina tracks.
- Raised the first hamster that ever went into space
- First to sing Uf Gozal in camp
- Once did lake swim back and forth five times Shabbat afternoon after playing basketball (she founded Palmer Ball).
- Named the town Palmer after her pet guinea pig Palmer Dragat Rubinstein. The little known full name of the town is Palmer Dragat Rubinstein.
- Once wrote a letter for every camper
- Her face was very briefly on the 2 dollar bill and the 22.5 cent stamp

Evelyn Derby (Derbevelyn)

You will have **until 8 o'clock** to complete **as many tasks as you can** with your tzrif. You will gain up to five points for each task you complete, depending on how well you complete them! It is up to you and your chanichim to choose which tasks you would like to attempt to complete. **Bring your tzrif score sheet, a writing implement and lots of energy** to each task! **Madrichim are allowed and encouraged to help** (especially with the more difficult tasks), as long as the chanichim are still engaged and participating as well!

### **How well do you know Machaneh Ramah?**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- Master answer sheet for all the trivia questions
- 20 sheets of trivia questions, to be handed out to each tzrif
- 4 pens

Scoring system:

- Each tzrif gets half a point for each correct question they answer – at most 5!

To run your station:

- Hand out trivia sheets to each tzrif that approaches. Make sure they fill out the sheets at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in check the sheets against your master list and score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Pin the Broach on the Evelyn**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- One poster of Evelyn
- 20 broaches to be stuck onto Evelyn
- pins or double sided tape
- Two bandanas to blindfold

Scoring system:

- 1 point = tried
- 2 points = got the broach on the poster
- 3 points = on her shirt
- 4 points = on the correct side of her shirt
- 5 points = on the collar, where it belongs

To run your station:

- Blindfold one volunteer from the tzrif, spin them around 3 times, give them the broach and point them in the direction of the poster. Make sure they don't wander off, but allow them to pin the broach anywhere generally on the wall around the poster. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **How well do you know Evelyn?**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- Master answer sheet for all the trivia questions
- 20 sheets of trivia questions, to be handed out to each tzrif
- 4 pens

Scoring system:

- Each tzrif gets half a point for each correct question they answer – at most 5!

To run your station:

- Hand out trivia sheets to each tzrif that approaches. Make sure they fill out the sheets at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in check the sheets against your master list and score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Evelyn Rondeau's flavors**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- Master list of all the flavors at Rondeau's
- 20 sheets of paper with exactly 48 lines on them (one for each flavor)
- 4 pens

Scoring System:

- 1 point = 5 flavors or more
- 2 points = 15 flavors or more
- 3 points = 25 flavors or more
- 4 points = 35 flavors or more
- 5 points = 45 flavors or more

To run your station:

- Hand out a sheet to each tzrif that approaches. Make sure they fill out the sheets at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in check the sheets against your master list and score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Evelyn Israeli Flag Painting**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- 20 blank sheets of white paper
- 5 cups of blue washable paint

Scoring System:

- 1 point = they somehow fail to complete the flag correctly
- 5 points = they created an Israeli flag

To run your station:

- Give each tzrif a sheet of white paper and a cup of washable paint. Inform them that they must create an Israeli flag using only the tips of their fingers. They have 3 minutes to create the flag. Once you see their flag, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Evelyn's fourth Shabbat morning rule**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- 20 sheets of paper
- 4 pens

Scoring System:

- You have a lot of leeway with this. Award points on a scale from 1 to 5 based on creativity, connection to Evelyn and connection to camp/ tzad aleph.

To run your station:

- Give each tzrif that approaches a piece of paper and a pen if they don't have a writing implement on them. Explain to them that when Evelyn began telling the story of the three rules of Shabbat breakfast years ago, there was a fourth rule that has since been lost. They must recreate that rule to the best of their ability. Read their rule, then write down their score on the score sheet so that they can move on to the next activity.

### **Evelyn's favorite musical**

You do not need any materials for your station!

Scoring System:

- You have a lot of leeway with this. Award points on a scale from 1 to 5 based on creativity, performance value and connection to Evelyn.

To run your station:

- Instruct each tzrif that comes approaches that they must perform a number from Evelyn's favorite musical. They can have up to 5 minutes to plan their performance. Their performance must include a brief explanation of why they chose their musical/ song and should not exceed one minute total. Immediately after they finish performing, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **Evelyn Anagrams**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- 20 pieces of paper with "Evelyn Dragat Rubinstein" written across the top of them
- 4 pens
- Stopwatch (can be on a phone or watch)

Scoring System:

- 1 point = 1 - 10 words
- 2 points = 11-20 words
- 3 points = 21-30 words
- 4 points = 31- 39 words
- 5 points = 40 words or more

To run your station:

- Hand each tzrif that approaches a piece of paper. They will have 2 minutes to come up with as many words using the letters in "Evelyn Dragat Rubinstein" as possible. After the two minutes are up, count up their words and write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **Camp Dances**

You don't need any materials to run this station!

Scoring System:

- You have a lot of leeway with this. Award points on a scale from 1 to 5 based on creativity, performance value, knowledge of the dance moves and connection to Evelyn.

To run your station:

- Instruct each tzrif to perform Evelyn's favorite camp dance to the best of their ability without music. They can have up to 3 minutes to plan their performance. Their performance must include a brief explanation of why they chose their dance and should not exceed one minute total. Immediately after they finish performing, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **Shir Ramah**

You should have the following materials at your station:



- A giant posterboard with the lyrics to Shir Ramah

Scoring System:

- 1 point = they tried
- 3 points = they were able to sing through the song successfully with the lyrics poster
- 5 points = they know the song! YAY!!

To run your station:

- Instruct each tzrif to sing Shir Ramah for you. They will be judged solely based on whether or not they know the song. If they are struggling, bring out the lyrics poster. Once they finish sing, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **What Would Evelyn Do?**

You don't need any materials to run your station!

Scoring System:

- You have a lot of leeway with this. Award points on a scale from 1 to 5 based on creativity and connection to Evelyn.

To run your station:

- Ask each tzrif that comes up, "Would Evelyn rather have to speak only in rhyme for the rest of her life or only in song? Why?" Give them up to 3 minutes to prepare an answer. Immediately after listening to their presentation, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity. Extra points if they do their presentation either in rhyme or song (you can suggest that).

### **Beat Josh in Connect Four**

You should have the following materials at your table:

- Josh
- A game of Connect Four

Scoring System:

- 1 point = they tried and lost
- 3 points = they tied
- 5 points = they beat Josh

To run your station:

- Each tzrif that approaches must nominate a champion to go up against Josh in a game of Connect Four. The game will go until someone wins or until three minutes is reached, whichever comes first.

### **How Well Do you know hanhallah?**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- Master answer sheet for all the trivia questions
- 20 sheets of trivia questions, to be handed out to each tzrif
- 4 pens

Scoring system:

- Each tzrif gets half a point for each correct question they answer – at most 5!

To run your station:

- Hand out trivia sheets to each tzrif that approaches. Make sure they fill out the sheets at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in check the sheets against your master list and score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Evelyn's family tree**

You will need the following materials for your station:

- 20 blank family trees
- Crayons, markers and/or other coloring implements
- 4 pens

Scoring System:

- You have a lot of leeway with this. Award points on a scale from 1 to 5 based on creativity, connection to Etz Hayim and connection to Evelyn.

To run your station:

- Each tzrif is given a blank family tree to fill in with Evelyn's parents, grandparents, siblings, children, nieces and nephews, and to decorate. Make sure they fill out the trees at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in, score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Evelyn Head's Up: Guess the animal from the animal noise**

You will need the following materials for your station:

- Cards with animals on them
- Stopwatch (a watch or phone can work)

Scoring System:

- 1 point = 1 animal
- 2 points = 2-3 animals
- 3 points = 4 animals
- 4 points = 5-6 animals
- 5 points = 7 or more animals

To run your station:

- Each tzrif should choose a person to be the clue giver to the rest of the tzrif. The clue giver must look at the animal cards and help the rest of their tzrif guess the animal using only noises. They are allowed to use minimal actions to assist in their clues, but the actions must accompany the noise, they can't be the entire clue. Once the minute is completed, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **Evelyn Sing Down**

You don't need any materials to run your station!

Scoring System:

- They get one point per song, with a maximum of five points.

To run your station:

- Each tzrif has two minutes to come up with as many songs as they can that contain the word "Evelyn" or words that sound sort of like "Evelyn". Be flexible with what

words sound like Evelyn, because very few songs contain the word Evelyn. They get one point per song. After they've reached five songs or the two minutes is up, write their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **Human Pyramids**

You don't need any materials to run your station!

Scoring System:

- They get one point per pyramid/ shape, with a maximum of five points.

To run your station:

- Each tzrif has two minutes to create as many of the following shapes with their bodies as possible: human pyramid, a tree, Evelyn's face, Evelyn's broach, their tzrif number. They can make these shapes consecutively, or multiple at the same time. Once the two minutes is completed, write their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **US Citizenship Test**

You will need the following materials for your station:

- Master list of the US Citizenship test answers
- 20 copies of the US Citizenship test
- 4 pens

Scoring System:

- They receive x points per question with a maximum of five points

To run your station:

- Hand out Citizenship tests to each tzrif that approaches. Make sure they fill out the sheets at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in check the sheets against your master list and score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **EDR: Name that Acronym!**

You will need the following materials for your station:

- 20 sheets of paper with EDR written on them multiple times
- 4 pens

Scoring System:

- They receive one point per acronym, with a maximum of five points

To run your station:

- Hand each group a sheet with the initials and explain that they are supposed to come up with as many phrases as possible (up to five) that EDR could stand for (for example: Every day rocks!) Make sure they fill out the sheets at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in check the sheets against your master list and score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Counting Circle B'Ivrit**

You need the following materials for your station:

- Stopwatch (can be a watch or phone)

### Scoring System:

- 1 point = they tried, but did not succeed
- 5 points = they succeeded

### To run your station:

- Working with one tzrif at a time, inform them that as a tzrif they must count from Echad to Eser. Anyone can say the next number, but if two people say it at the same time, they must start over. They will not be given any planning time and can't talk (except for saying numbers). They will be given one minute to succeed. Once the minute is up, write down their score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

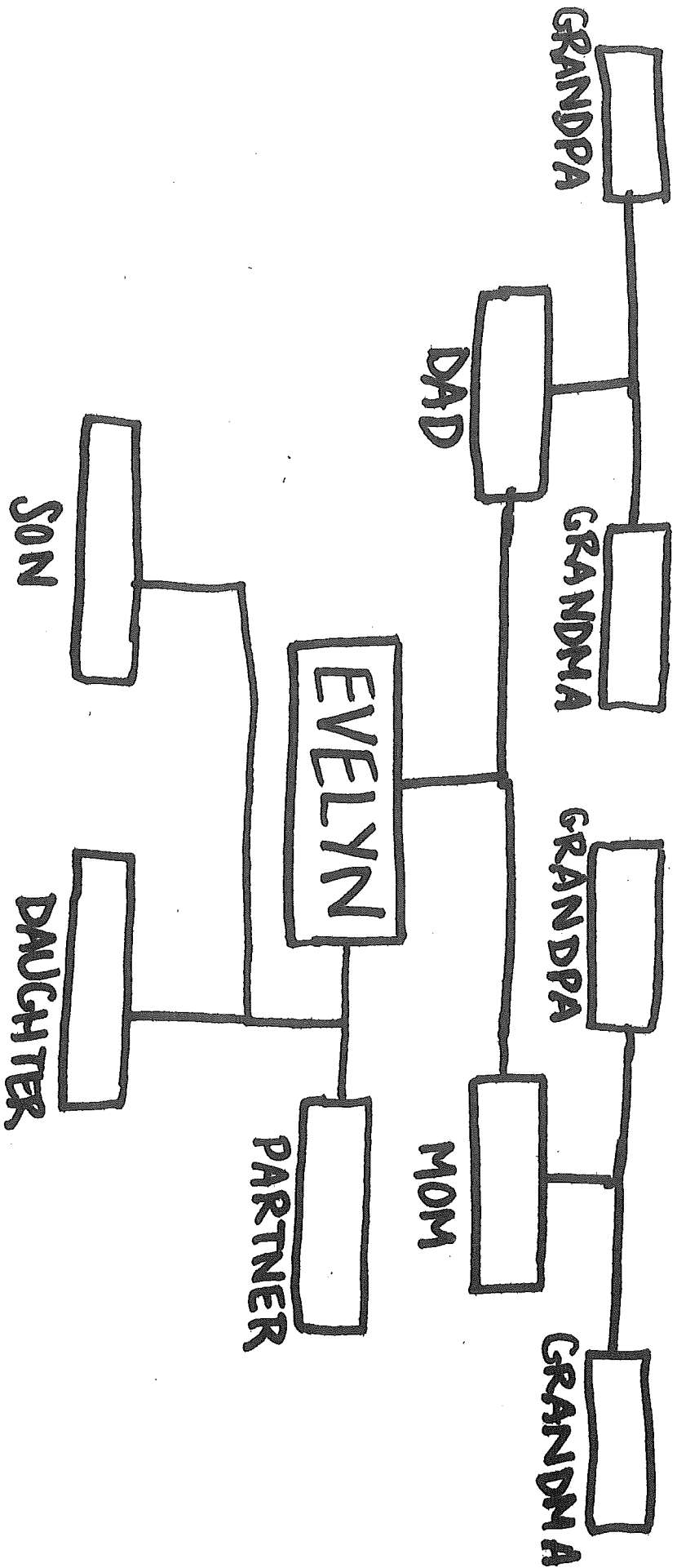

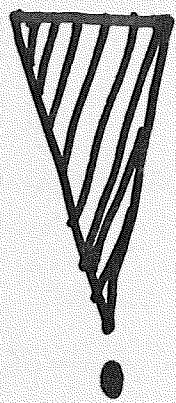

Josh and David,

I know that Josh hates to muck with the Evelyn tall tales, but I'm sitting here with the old scrapbook, which reveals:

- Evelyn's group was called the Women's Organization for Camp Ramah in New England, and it was formed in 1961. It grew to over 700 members.
- It looks like each of the New England sisterhoods had a "Ramah chairman," and these women were attached to the Women's Organization for CRNE
- Dues to the Women's Org were \$1. "Life members" gave \$25.
- Broke ground for library in 1966
- Library dedicated on July 30, 1967
- It was originally called the "Library Building of the Women's Organization of Camp Ramah in New England" but was dedicated to Evelyn at the time of the groundbreaking
- There was a Tree of Life membership painting for the organization, with the names of the Life Members
- The building costs were \$21,500
- Evelyn died July 12, 1969
- There were 517 campers in 1967
- The building had 16 classrooms, in addition to the library and an "all-purpose room"
- She was a public school teacher for 30 years. She also took special interest in serving children who were blind.

Unrelated: a 1969 pamphlet for Visiting Day indicated that the barber would give the children haircuts!

### **Pin the Broach on the Evelyn**

- You have a lot of leeway with this. Award points on a scale from 1 to 5 based on creativity, performance value and connection to Evelyn.

To run your station:

- Instruct each tzrif that comes approaches that they must perform a number from Evelyn's favorite musical. They can have up to 5 minutes to plan their performance. Their performance must include a brief explanation of why they chose their musical/ song and should not exceed one minute total. Immediately after they finish performing, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **Camp Dances**

You don't need any materials to run this station!

Scoring System:

- You have a lot of leeway with this. Award points on a scale from 1 to 5 based on creativity, performance value, knowledge of the dance moves and connection to Evelyn.

To run your station:

- Instruct each tzrif to perform Evelyn's favorite camp dance to the best of their ability without music. They can have up to 3 minutes to plan their performance. Their performance must include a brief explanation of why they chose their dance and should not exceed one minute total. Immediately after they finish performing, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

### **Shir Ramah**

You should have the following materials at your station:

- A giant posterboard with the lyrics to Shir Ramah

Scoring System:

- 1 point = they tried
- 3 points = they were able to sing through the song successfully with the lyrics poster
- 5 points = they know the song! YAY!!

To run your station:

- Instruct each tzrif to sing Shir Ramah for you. They will be judged solely based on whether or not they know the song. If they are struggling, bring out the lyrics poster. Once they finish sing, write down their score on the score sheet so they can move on to the next activity.

- 20 sheets of trivia questions, to be handed out to each tzrif
- 4 pens

Scoring system:

- Each tzrif gets half a point for each correct question they answer – at most 5!

To run your station:

- Hand out trivia sheets to each tzrif that approaches. Make sure they fill out the sheets at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in check the sheets against your master list and score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Evelyn's family tree**

You will need the following materials for your station:

- 20 blank family trees
- Crayons, markers and/or other coloring implements
- 4 pens

Scoring System:

- You have a lot of leeway with this. Award points on a scale from 1 to 5 based on creativity, connection to Etz Hayim and connection to Evelyn.

To run your station:

- Each tzrif is given a blank family tree to fill in with Evelyn's parents, grandparents, siblings, children, nieces and nephews, and to decorate. Make sure they fill out the trees at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in, score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Evelyn Head's Up: Guess the animal from the animal noise**

You will need the following materials for your station:

- Phone with animal emoji list
- Stopwatch (a watch or phone can work)

Scoring System:

- 1 point = 1 animal
- 2 points = 2-3 animals
- 3 points = 4 animals
- 4 points = 5-6 animals
- 5 points = 7 or more animals

To run your station:

- Each tzrif should choose a person to be the clue giver to the rest of the tzrif. The clue giver must look at the animal cards and help the rest of their tzrif guess the animal using only noises. They are allowed to use minimal actions to assist in their clues, but the actions must accompany the noise, they can't be the entire clue. - Hand out Citizenship tests to each tzrif that approaches. Make sure they fill out the sheets at your station – they cannot leave with the sheets. Once they are handed in

check the sheets against your master list and score them QUICKLY. Write down the score on their score sheet so they can move on to their next activity.

### **Impersonation Manifestation**

You will need no material for your station:

- 1 point = It's clear the performer has not actually met her/his rosh edah
- 5 points = You actually mistake the performer for the rosh edah

To run your station:

- One tzrif at a time selects an Impersonation Manifestation Representative (IMR).

That person is responsible for impersonating that tzrif's rosh edah in such a way that their presentation mimics said rosh edah trapped in an invisible box. Do not mistake this for a miming activity, for, in fact, the IMR may speak freely.

### **Last Dragat Standing**

Tzrif has one minute and twenty seven seconds to convince the runner of this station which Hanhallah member is actually the sole descendant of Evelyn D. R. and why that is the case. Rate on a scale of 1 – 5 based on argumentation, creativity, inclusion, and good looks.
