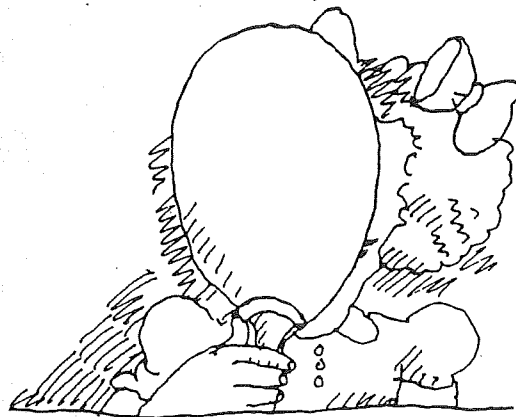

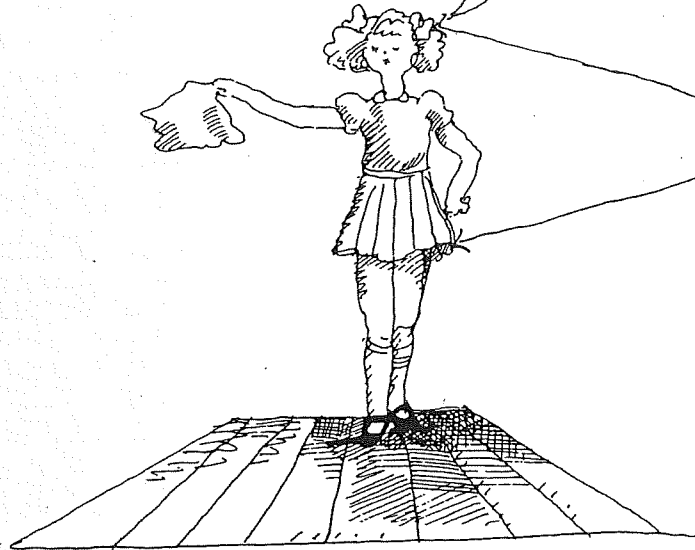

Girl 1:

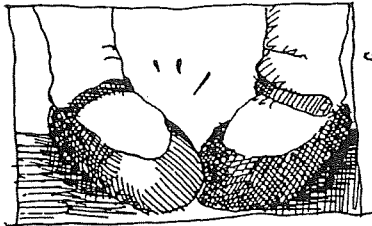
I wear lovely starched cotton dresses with matching ribbons in

N. 2: When she was at the end of the lunch line at school, all she had to say was,

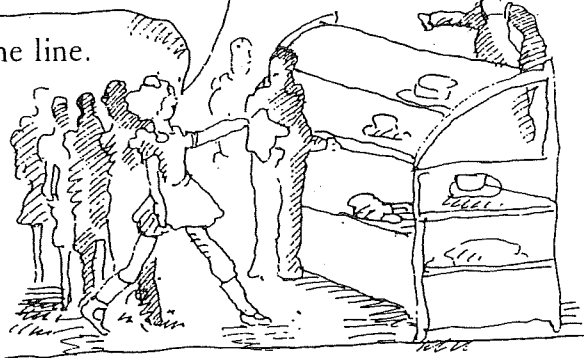

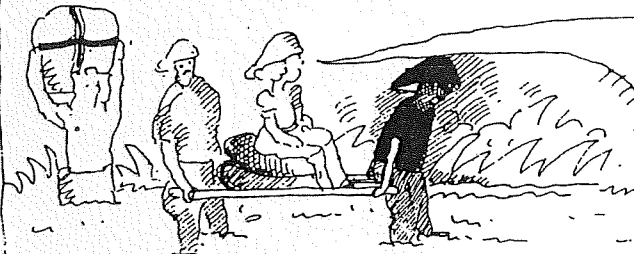

N. 2 And they did.





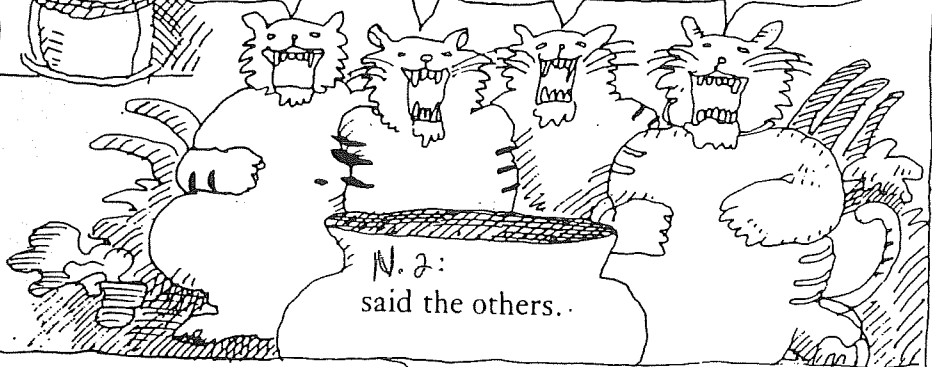

How about *this* one then? It looks tender, smells nice, in fact, I never saw anything quite like it before. I wonder what it is."

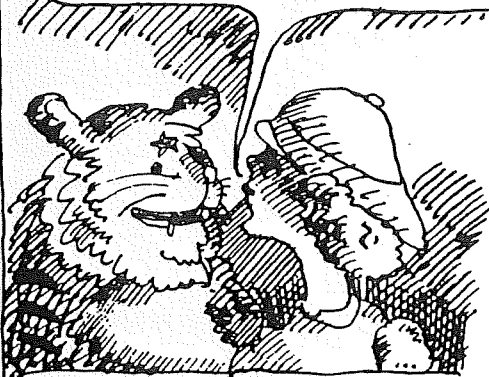
