CARDBOARD CAR RACING

Materials: 5 cardboard boxes, towels or cones for borders, markers, construction paper

Location: Upper Midrash

Procedure:

1. each tzrif will receive one cardboard box as their racing car
2. each tzrif will spend 10-15 minutes decorating their racing car
3. 10:20-10:40 race cars we will make the course either out of towel, benches or both

Human Foosball

Procedure: Set up benches on upper migrash (two games going on)
6 Benches per game (12 total)
Goalie/7 defense/7 offense (per team)
Before their goal can count they have to answer a Jewish/Parsha questions as a team.

Goal: Teamwork
You can't score a goal on your own

Tziporim Koasim (Angry Birds) Procedure:

Divide them up by random groups of 16 or 17 (4 total groups)

During Mechuchah/Peulat Tzrif a few counselors go to the tennis court and set up with bench, tables, mats, chairs, other things that can be used for a blockade.

Rules for dodgeball:

- 1) If you get hit with the ball you are out
- 2) If you knock over a boundary you need to run around in a circle 2 times and say mazel tov (you cannot get out while doing this)
- 3) You must dress up as birds or pigs (pre-assigned)
