Explanations of the Yom:- Ziv

Each team's goal in mesibat Mario is to collect more stars than any other team by the end of the day. The simplest way to collect stars is through winning the mini games. The place you get in certain mini games will allow your team to roll the die first, before any other team gets the chance to roll it. Each face of the die will represent a location in camp. Once your team has rolled a specific location, you have the right to send a scout out to that location to look to see if there is a star there before the next team rolls. Please note that the star will only be at one out of the six specific locations at all points in time during the day. If your team doesn't have any luck with the dice over the course of the day, don't worry. Winning certain mini games also allows your team to gain coins. You can then use these coins to pay Bowser to steal another team's star and deliver it to your team. At the very end of the day, we will be giving out additional stars for team spirit and how each team utilized teamwork and other categories throughout the day. It will be after this ceremony that the team with the most stars shall be selected the winning team of yom mesibat Mario.

Mini-Games explanation:

Beit am Bet:

Bubble Rap- Each team will be given a certain amount of bubble rap. Each team's goal will be to pop all of the bubbles in the shortest amount of time. EVERY PERSON must pop at least five bubbles.

Paper Air plane- Each team will be given paper and paper clips and will have to make paper airplanes. The team that can throw any of their airplanes the furthest wins

Wipe Down the Square- One person will go into the middle of the square that is created with painters tape on the floor and be blindfolded and spun around. The rest of the team will have to guide the person in the square and help them sweep the scrap paper out of the square by providing directions to do so. There will be multiple rounds. They are timed.

Fruit by the foot game: Each team will have everyone participate in this challenge. Campers will be eating fruit by the foot and cereal on the floor placed on paper table clothes, army crawling. The first team to eat to the end wins.

Sock Wrestling: Migrash: 3 people from each team put on as many clothes as humanly possible. Give the campers directions to dress up and wear the clothes without telling them what event they are doing. Then when they come back we will give them socks to put on one foot. They will proceed to sock wrestle and the winner is the one whose sock never comes off. Goal: take off opponents sock. keep yours on.

Deluxe Water Balloon Toss: Migrash: Each team will be given 10 water balloons, everyone on each team will form a vertical line on the migrash. The first two people in each line of every team will proceed to toss the water balloon between each other at the same time, moving further and further back till they no longer feel it is "safe" to throw the balloon back and forth, because if it breaks they have to start over. when the first group doesn't feel comfortable anymore the next pair on that team goes. Since the team has 11 people, the pairs have a second chance at another balloon if they choose use it and start over. **EACH TEAM HAS 10 BALLOONS ONLY**

Ohel: Food activity: Facelift: Every team is given a picture of the character Bowser, and they have to create that picture on the cake given to them. Each team gets more ingredients to add to their cake when they show the judges(aka Ari, Zeev, Ziv, Miriam) their respective cheers and act in character. The cake that looks most like the picture in the end wins

Agam Beach:

Bury Treasure: We shall bury items into the sand and each team will have to find the items on the agam beach. Whoever has the most items at the end of the game will win the most coins.

This is an activity for coins.

Capture the star: B-side Migrash or Niv Migrash (machne gimmel)

Split up 3 teams into 1 team, so a total of two teams. There is one star on each side of the migrash will a line splitting up the sides. If the other team is on the other side and are tagged they must be escorted to Bowser's Dungeon which is off to the side of the field, which is guarded, by Bowser and Baby Bowser (Ziv and Zeev). Every team member that is tagged goes to the same jail. however, the twist is that only same team members (out of the 6) can free their team members out of jail. Ex. Only people on Mario's team can save people on Mario's team by tagging one of the members, regardless to who they as a team are together with during this game. Bowser's POWERS: tagging, and fireballs (they will have dodge balls to throw at campers that also gets the people trying to free people from jail out if hit)

The Significance of going to the Bathroom

Background to present to campers: We go to the bathroom every day? But have we ever thought about how thankful we must be for having our bodies working properly? There are a lot of people in the world that have problems with the most basic functions that we take for granted everyday. For example, going to the bathroom.

Read to campers

There are Jewish prayers for practically everything. Including daily routine activities such as going to the bathroom. The *Asher Yatzar* blessing thanks God for creating the complexity of the human body and for the gracious gift of its proper functioning. It is recited everyday, every morning, as part of the Birchot HaShachar prayer and we should say it every time we use the bathroom. The English translation is as follows.

"Blessed are You, Hashem our G-d, King of the universe, Who formed people with wisdom and created within us many openings and many hollows. It is obvious and known before Your Throne of Glory that if even one of them ruptures, or if even one of them becomes blocked, it would be impossible to survive and to stand before You (even for a short period). Blessed are You, Hashem, Who heals all flesh and acts wondrously."

Key point: We shouldn't wait until we get sick to appreciate our health.

Questions to ask Campers:

Why have a blessing like this?

What is the significance of giving thanks to the little things in life, that we practically find insignificant? Examples: walking, eating, using the bathroom?

What other things do we take for granted everyday? (have each camper go around and say one thing)
