# New York Marathon (Apache Relay) for Yom NYC

There will be one counselor at almost every station. Just make sure the kids do their tasks and don't kill themselves; things should go pretty smoothly. Everything will take place on the upper migrash.

The teams are divided into two teams, Uptown and Downtown and both have 21 kids. We will meet at a specified time, probably 2.30, so that all the kids can get signed up and then we can go and not have leftover time. Sit down with the kids to sign them up (please put their names in the blanks) and just remind them which activities they are doing. They will have five minutes to get ready after being assigned everything.

AT THE END OF EACH ACTIVITY, the kids will congregate in the middle of the migrash, in their teams, and will all have to do the Vampire Dance. Whoever finishes the dance first wins!

Downtown: Nathan, Hayden, Danny, Yael, Abby, Katie

Have fun!

1. Start at the corner of the migrash by Bunk 1 and the Bet Am Alef. Camper #1 will do a lap around the migrash.
2. After the lap, Camper #2 will be waiting at the original spot and will do two (2) cartwheels, four (4) somersaults, and fifteen (15) jumping jacks (star jumps).
3. Once Camper #2 has finished the acrobatics, Camper #3 will have to walk, spoon-in-mouth, probably balancing a ball or a rock, across the migrash to 32.
4. Camper #4 will be waiting at 32 and will then have to completely change clothes (shirt, shorts, socks, shoes) and run back out and tag Campers #5 and #6.
5. Campers #5 and #6 will team up to be three-legged and run to the Gan from 32.
6. At the Gan, Camper #7 will sing the Camp Ramah song.
7. Camper #8 will dribble a soccer ball up the migrash to where the food tent is. The kid actually has to dribble the soccer ball, not just kick it across the field. That would be lame.
8. At the food tent, Camper #9 will have to recite the blessing for fruit, bread, and dessert.
9. Campers #10 and #11 will be waiting at the food tent and will do the wheelbarrow walk to the swings.
10. At the swings, Camper #12 will have to swing and whistle the chorus from the umbrella song (the one we did for Zimkudiyah).

11. After Camper #12 gets off the swings, Camper #13 will spin around a baseball bat and run to the porch of 17/18.
12. Campers #14 and #15 will have to find all the words in a word find. Fun! Then they have to chug a glass of water each.
13. Camper #16 will be waiting at the porch (no helping the other campers with the word find!) to run a lap around the migrash backwards. That means the kid will start at 17/18 and literally run backwards, past 15/16, past 32, etc.
14. Camper #17 has to meet Camper #16 at the porch of 17/18 and do the crabwalk across the field to the Bet Am Alef.
15. Camper #18 will stand on the steps of the Bet Am Alef and belt out the שאלה's and then count backwards from ten to one in Hebrew.
16. Camper #19 will also be on the steps. After Camper #18 finishes, #19 will attempt at the best Josh Edelglass impression ever and run to Bunk 1.
17. Camper #20 will be at Bunk 1 and will sing "HaTikvah" really, really loudly.
18. Camper #21 will then have to name 25 of the fifty states. Just for fun. Upon completion, said camper will run to the middle to join everyone else from the team and they will all do the Vampire Dance.
