Instructions for running the program

- 10 minutes: Josh Edelglass introduces good life chug
- 5 minutes: divide into groups
- 10 minutes: icebreakers- quick name go around, one word stories (each kid says one word to tell a story)
- 3 minute shtick- finding the artifacts (random objects) that have been 'hidden' around the moadon
- 10 minutes: bag of "artifacts" have to create a story and a presentation about the history of Shoafim. 1 item per kid, each has to explain their artifact
- 10 minutes: each group presents their story
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
